## Member updates

At our June membership meeting, we asked everyone to share how their return-to-the-field efforts were going. Some organizations are not yet sending their CHWs back in the field.

- Andrea of the Ferndale School District closed out the school year collecting computers from the families and checking in with them, from a safe distance
- Katie of Unity Care NW is working on a field-work guideline, partially based on the CDC Homeless Outreach and King County Homeless Outreach. Unity Care NW is also beginning a partnership with the County Health Department, working together to identify high risk groups for COVID education.
- Tess at Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Services said their patient advocates are self-quarantining for 2 weeks before seeing clients
- Most organizations are reporting temperature checks, masks, and keeping a 6-foot distance from clients

Danny at L&I is doing outreach through Agape Service Project and mobile food banks, and **looking for partnerships with other orgs that serve limited English-speaking communities**
